Caregiver at Belfry Schools On-Site Daycare

Overview

We are seeking a compassionate and experienced Caregiver to join our team at an on-site daycare facility catering specifically to the children of our teachers and staff members. As a Caregiver, you will play a crucial role in providing a safe, nurturing, and educational environment for the children while their parents work. Responsibilities

- 4. Ability to pass a drug test and background check and maintain confidentiality regarding sensitive information.
- 5. 18+ years of age
